

Overview

Regular proficiency training is essential to the safety of all pilots and their passengers. Each pilot must take a personal interest in their safety and that of their passengers. Avia's *Flight Review course* is predicated on the FAA's recently updated Pilot Proficiency program (WINGS), and includes both a knowledge and a flight segment. Pilots can complete the entire knowledge (ground) portion online at their own pace, and in the convenience of their home or office. The flight segment includes a minimum of one airplane and one simulator session during which the applicant must demonstrate PTS proficiency in the maneuvers required by the FAA.

The WINGS - Pilot Proficiency Program is designed to help each pilot construct an educational curriculum suitable for their unique flight requirements. It encourages pilots to continue their aviation educational pursuits and requires education, review, and flight proficiency in the Areas of Operation found in current Practical Test Standards (PTS), that correspond with the leading accident causal factors.

Prerequisites

To be eligible for enrollment in Avia's *Flight Review course*, the candidate must

- Be registered with FAA FAAST (www.faasafety.gov)
- Have an FAA FAAST WINGS account established (free)
- Have accomplished at least the required Basic knowledge credits (online courses at www.faasafety.gov)



Course Completion Requirements

To be eligible for course completion, the candidate must

- Satisfactorily complete all knowledge and flight credits for completion of the WINGS program (minimum Basic phase)

- After completing tutorial, click on "Start My WINGS" link
- Create FAA FAAST account
- Obtain required knowledge credits for Basic phase by taking FAA online courses
- Print completion certificates and submit copies to Avia
- Schedule simulator and flight session with Avia
- Enter completed simulator/flight training sessions into your WINGS account
- Instructor must validate flight training online to complete Flight Review
